- All our newspapers have planned, tried and tested distribution and outlets, reaching readers in their homes or at well known retailers.

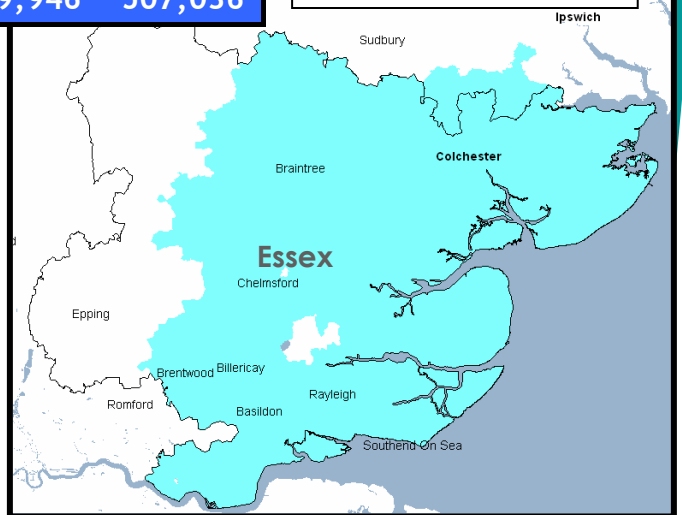
